## **Bachelor of Science in Professional Aeronautics**

The Professional Aeronautics degree program is designed specifically for students who work, have worked, or desire to work in aviation related careers. For students with existing aviation related knowledge and skills, the program recognizes those skills through award of advanced standing prior-learning credit.

The Professional Aeronautics degree program was developed for the individual who has already acquired aviation knowledge and skills through a combination of training and experience. As a graduate with a degree in Professional Aeronautics, your job search should be tailored to your experience. Armed with that experience and a bachelor's degree from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, you can aim toward positions of greater responsibility.

The type of position you should target depends on your background, experience, and what your career ambitions are. Your strengths in the job search market are the skills and experience you have acquired, combined with your education. Review what you have done in the past to identify those skills you can highlight for an employer. Examples include: management/supervisory skills, project management, planning and organizing capabilities, analytical skills, computer skills, etc. If you are prior military or changing fields, identify those skills that are transferable to the positions for which you are interested in applying.

Employers do not contact the Career Services Office specifically asking to view resumes of Professional Aeronautics graduates. They do, however, contact us with open positions in specific fields such as business, management, maintenance, safety, and flight, for which these graduates often qualify.

## **Bachelor of Science in Technical Management**

In the Technical Management degree program, students learn how to apply specific management skills to their technical specialty. This unique degree has evolved into a technical program relating to industry as a whole. The curriculum emphasizes modern management concepts and methods and gives students a set of well-defined technical tools. It also focuses on building the communication and management skills that are needed in technically-oriented enterprises. Major management disciplines are studied as a foundation for large-scale planning and decision-making, and students enhance classroom interaction by sharing perspectives and experiences from their work situations. Graduates with previous relevant experience will be more likely to move directly into management positions upon graduation, whereas those graduates with

limited or no relevant experience may have to start in an entry-level position and work their way up to management.

The degree gives air traffic control personnel, aviation educators, flight crewmembers, flight operations specialists, and industry technical representatives an unequalled opportunity to enhance their knowledge and pursue additional opportunities. While potential career areas are vast, they are based primarily on the education (minors selected) and previous experience of the individual.

There are many areas available for a MAS student to utilize their degree. However, we must emphasize that no student is limited to these areas, which are based on chosen areas of specialization. There are several factors to consider when applying for a job. For example, some positions you may apply to will require some type of experience. In addition, the employer may take into consideration your undergraduate degree. The student must research the company and job requirements to determine if he or she is qualified.

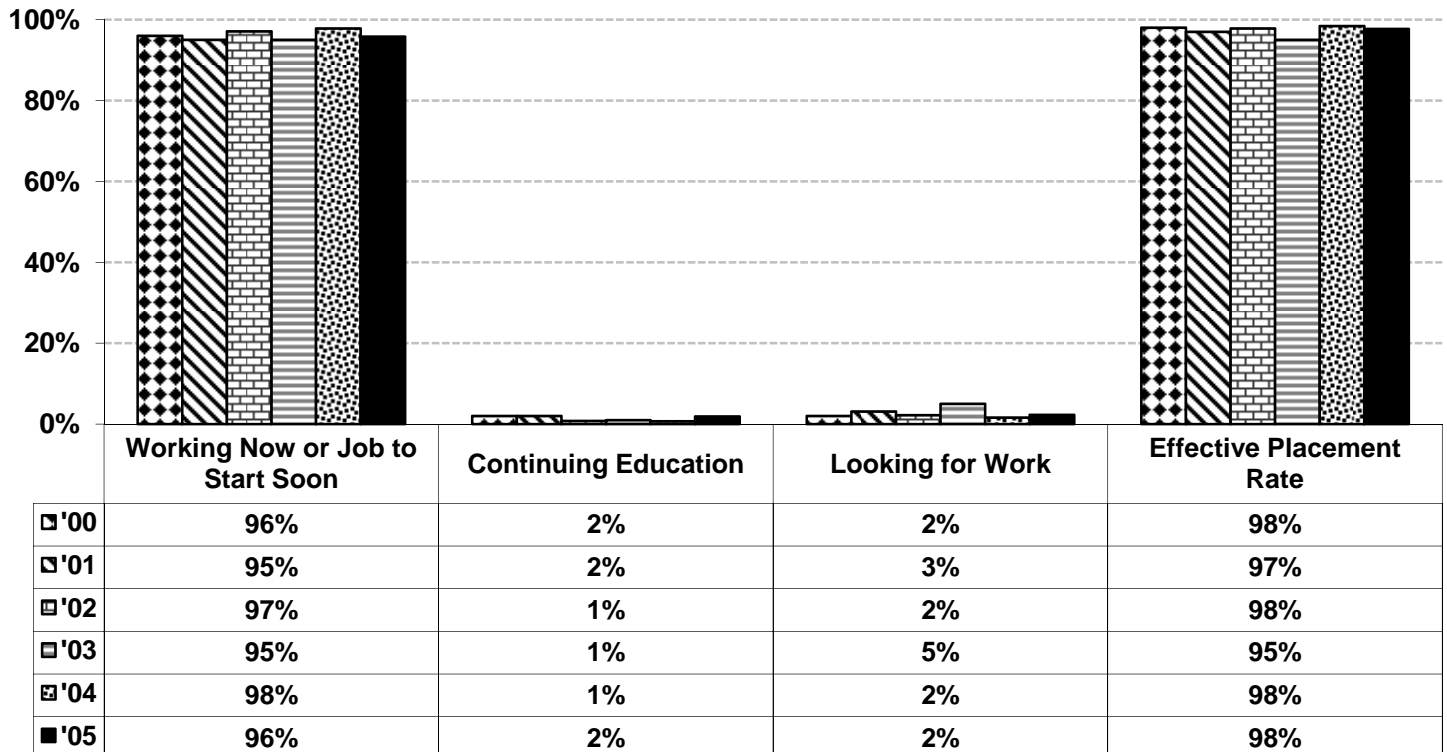

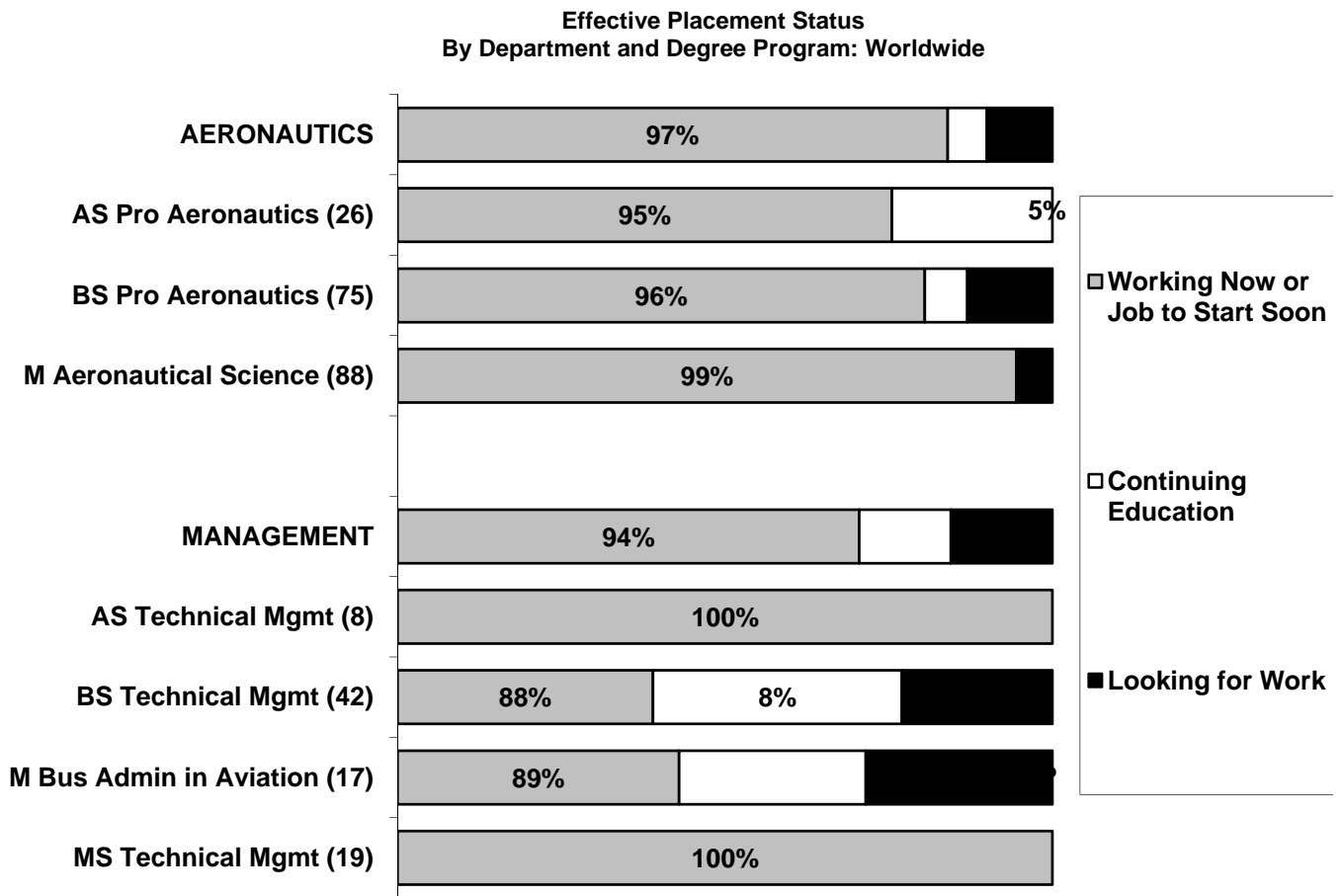
